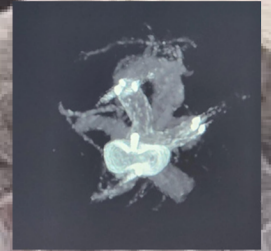
MESSAGE FROM THE PATRON

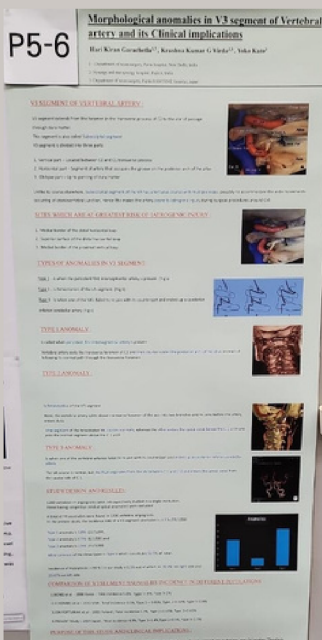
CONFERENCES AND WORKSHOPS

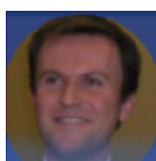

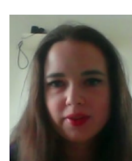

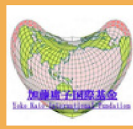
