OUR 1ST WEBNAR WITH SENSEI PROF ALBERTO






We had 2 amazing weeks in ICU learns about critical care nursing, we observed Tracheostomy Insertion procedure and care, dialysis

PICC, Angel care, Extubation and Intubation (modern way) with modern equipment, Teamwork highly observed post operation receiving Emergency preparedness, timely medication, use of scanner for prior medications, proper documentation, changing

position, communication between nurses and patients well done, availability of equipment, suction with disposable bags. Critical cares, Doctors are readily available most of the time. In the ward well received with nurse in charge, we observed good communication between nurse, patient and family members. Rehabilitation we were received with the DR In charge and other staff members, were oriented and had fixed time table strict and very smart staff were

aware and responsible for our presence, staff taught us everything they do to the patient. New equipment and modern way of doing procedures, like Endoscopic Video, Magnetic stimulation, speech therapy, occupational therapy, of which in our work setting is not yet done. Evaluation after the investigation (well done) Rehabilitation team is eager to learn from what we do too, staff treat patients like their family members with love.
